Jesus, not him!' Why was it a surprise? Christians teach that Jesus brought good news because he was a friend to those left out by other people Act out: Ask pupils to dramatise the story in groups of six Include a chorus which repeats 'Oh no, Jesus, not him', and then 'Good news: Jesus welcomed everyone'

APPENDIX T Exemplar Unit of Work: KS1 Celebrations
